Swing!, California Musical Theatre (Music Circus)

Review: Fun and entertaining as far as musicians and singers go. As for dance, well, I think an audience that has become more educated about what good dancing looks like thanks to reality TV dance competitions (I'm thinking about So You Think You Can Dance but I'm sure Dancing With The Stars, etc. also qualify) deserves better. The dancing had some exuberant moments (usually via the tiny flame-haired spitfire), but mostly, mainly in the group numbers, it was lazy and half-hearted.
