Review: I have been waiting to see this production since I heard it was coming to the stage in Sacramento. I am delighted to say I was not disappointed. Unfortunately, many stage productions of Dracula end up campy, and missing the sense of urgent action. This production does not. It stayed true to the horror of the original story, and did not sink into the silly "Dracula" cartoon. This is due in part to Ryan Williams' on spot performance as the title role. The cast and costuming captured the feel of Gothic mystery from the very first scene. Of particular note was Nick Gailbreath's striking portrayal of the frenzied, and single minded Vampire hunter Van Helsing. The original "Ahab" of the horror genre, Van Helsing drives the intensity of the story through his dogmatic investigation and persecution of the ultimately tragic King of the Vampires. Bravo. I will - certainly- see this production again before it leaves the stage.
