### *A Christmas Carol*, Sacramento Theatre Company

**Review:** Fantastic production! This was my first time seeing STC's musical "Christmas Carol" and my daughter and I thoroughly enjoyed it. The staging was effective and -- oh, the cast! -- truly a wonderful evening. I found the "Christmas past" segment particularly poignant; the use of actors of varying ages effectively and "hauntingly" portrayed Scrooge's transformation from innocent youth to money-fixated, angry loner. On Christmas morning, when Scrooge rejoins the "real world" -- disavowing his greedy ways and embracing the truth and beauty he remembered as a child, his exuberance and joy are a treat to withhold. This show was a true holiday special -- a sweet and funny reminder that the season of light and giving is the time for all of us, regardless of religious faith or background, to feel gratitude for what we have and extend compassion to those who have little. Dickens himself would have applauded.
