See What I Wanna See, Artistic Differences Theatre Company

Review: This is my second visit to Artistic Difference's show. True to their missions, they are producing a high quality show that is rarely produced in Sacramento Region. I LOVED the high quality of the band, and for a small theatre to be able to bring in an excellent live music, I really appreciate their effort. The performance by the entire cast was also enjoyable, especially Maggie Hollinbeck's voice was unbelievable. This show is for people who crave "something different and intriguing" in a live theatre. Highly recommended.

Review: Artistic Differences says that they produce musicals that aren't seen anywhere else, and I am so glad they do. See What I Want To See is unusual and thought provoking. It is impossible to see this show and not be engaged every minute, putting together all the pieces and the conclusion you come to is bound to be different from the person sitting next to you. Amazing actor/singers and live music elevate this show. Do yourself a favor and see it before it's gone. I know it is one that I will be thinking about long after this season is passed - and it already has my vote for best local production this year.

Review: Artistic Differences is one of the gems in the Sacramento theatre scene crown. They continue their run of hits with See What I Wanna See, a thought provoking, interesting and deeply moving musical drama. The performances are all equally wonderful...it is a joy to listen to the 5 actors sing. You won't have a chance to see this piece very often, and if you have any remote interest in musical theatre you should plan on seeing this show before it closes on May 3.

Review: Go see this production! No, it's not a title with which you may be familiar, but you owe it to yourself to see this show. It's yet another very fine production by the talented theatre artists at Artistic Differences, and you need to support the work of this innovative and daring theatrical troupe. This is a musical that will entertain you, shock you, and challenge you. The performances are some of the finest you'll see this season, and the entire production is admirable.

Review: This show was my first experience with Artistic Differences and my first locally produced show in a very long time. I love musical theatre and have seen 9 shows already this year in New York, San Francisco, and Los Angeles and I have to say See What I Wanna See held it's own and blew me away. I've been listening to the original SWIWS recording since 2005 and was thrilled to hear and see these local actors nailing these complex songs with such apparent ease. And the mini-orchestra was amazing and wonderful

to see on stage. I enjoyed the show so much and am planning on returning before it ends and bringing more friends and family. I urge anyone reading this to do the same. You will not be disappointed. Thank you Artistic Differences for restoring my faith in local theatre and for bringing this show to Sacramento. I saw what I wanted to see and I wanna see it again!!
