credits all over town, I was highly disappointed overall. Kristine David as Rosemary was boring and a little annoying. I didn't like a single moment of her performance. Scott Divine as Otto Von Brunno, et al, had great physicality in his multiple characters, but his accents didn't allow most of his dialogue to be understood. He did have a great scene with himself with some marvelous changes between two characters that was very funny, but would have been even better if he was intelligible. He was also a little too loud for such a small space. Beth Edwards played Lenya Von Brunno as Natasha from Rocky and Bullwinkle. Intentionally done or not, it didn't work for me. Simon Hunt in the title role was fantastically funny! Great timing and enough honesty in the role to make the character really believable and likable, and still someone an audience can laugh at. However, the real diamond in this show is Matthew Russell playing 6(!) characters. He created a group of 6 amazingly different and incredibly funny folk each with a different voice, physicality, and quirk (and hair!). 90% of the laughs in this show are due to this fantastic comedian and the great comedic chemistry between Russell and Hunt. The other 10% tended to fall into the "cheap jokes" category, such as excessive body hair. Overall, I thought this a fun bit of theatre but not anything to get super excited about. Ticket price was a bit high for what I got.
