Every Christmas Story Ever Told (And Then Some!), Capital Stage

Review: This show really does mark the beginning of my Holiday season. It's so light and funny, and just brings home all the holiday moments from my childhood. New cast member Jonathan Williams steps into the role vacated by Eric Wheeler, and fills his shoes admirably (I did miss Eric's Scrooge a la Mr. Burns, but was treated to a HYSTERICAL Scottish Christmas by Jonathan, so it all worked out). They've announced that this is the last year they're going to be presenting 'Every Christmas Story Ever Told' so you want to make sure you catch this wonderful production. It just won't seem like Christmas next year without it.
